Personal, Social and Emotional Development



To become a **'Fantastic Fox and Terrific Tiger'** who is determined to complete a goal, resilience in the face of challenges and shows curiosity about the world around them. Can manage their own basic personal needs and understand the importance of healthy choices. Who shows empathy to others, forming positive relationships with adults and children, playing cooperatively.

Outdoor Physical Development



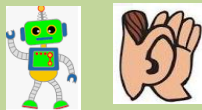
To become a **'Risk Taker'** who can use strength, balance and co-ordination to run, jump, hop, skip, climb and dance confidently and safely, negotiating space and obstacles, enjoying indoor, outdoor and Forest spaces safely. Who enjoys sessions using the balance bikes.

Fine Motor Development - Writing Skills



To become a **'Talented Tool user'** who holds a pencil effectively beginning to show accuracy and care when drawing. Who uses a range of small tools, scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery with confidence.

Literacy - Phonics



To become a **'Fabulous Phonics Extraordinaire'** who recognises and uses the phase 2 and 3 phonemes and digraphs to support their reading and writing.

Literacy - Writing



To become a **'Sentence Superstar'** who can write sentences (with words containing single sounds and digraphs) and who can also write a simple story for a friend to read. Who can form letters correctly using the cursive style handwriting.

Literacy - Reading



To become a **'Storyteller'** who can read books containing words they can decode (which are made up of single sounds {g, c} and digraphs {ee, igh}) and they can chat about what they have read and anticipate what might happen next. Who can confidently read all set 1, 2 and 3 high frequency words. To enjoy taking part with special 'author events'.



Maths



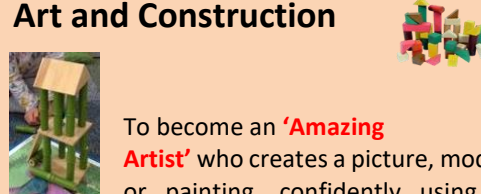
To become an **'Early Maths Master'** who has a deep understanding of numbers to 10, subitise up to 5 and recall number bonds to 5 in a flash! Who can verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system, compare quantities and explore number patterns including odds and evens.

Understanding the World



To become an **'Excited Explorer'** who understands how to read a simple map, shows care to living creatures and the environment, who can notice and describe changing of seasons and states of matter. Who knows their own family tree, understands some differences between our country and other countries and can talk about things from their past. Enjoying Forest School, trips to our local environment and a farm.

Art and Construction



To become an **'Amazing Artist'** who creates a picture, model or painting, confidently using a variety of tools and techniques. To be able to express their thoughts and ideas behind their work.
