### What's Been Keeping Governors Busy This Term

As you will know no doubt know, our Headteacher Mr Fowler is resigning at the end of the school year, after 24 years of outstanding service to the school and our community, as well as to the wider educational establishment.

Appointing a new headteacher is possibly the most important job school governors have to do and is very time intensive so, although Mr Fowler will be with us until the end of the Summer term 2019, Governors have been working this term towards the selection process for potential candidates for the post.

It is very important to us that we recruit a headteacher who will drive forward our Granby ethos, vision and values and who believes that the children should be at the centre of all the decisions we make, as well as being an excellent practitioner.
